



Privacy Policy

This policy explains what types of personal information will be gathered when you visit St Augustine's website, and how the information will be used

Information collected

On some parts of the website you may be asked to provide personal information in order to apply for a place; order a prospectus; book a place on a workshop; book an open event; or join our alumni 'friends' association. St Augustine's will store this information manually or electronically. By supplying this information you are consenting to St Augustine's holding and using it for the purposes for which it was provided. Information provided will be kept for as long as is necessary to fulfil that purpose.

How the information is used

Personal information provided to St Augustine's by you will only be used for the purposes stated when the information is requested. Personal information will not be sold to 3rd parties, or provided to direct marketing companies or other such organisations without your permission. Personal information collected is held in accordance with the provisions of the Data Protection Act 1998.

How we store information collected

Information which you provide to us will ordinarily be stored on our secure server. Manual data is protected by locking relevant doors and cupboards, shredding and internal procedures.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer when you visit a website. They are widely used in order to make websites work more efficiently and provide basic functionality such as remembering preferences or filling out forms. They are also used to provide information and insights to the owners of the site that help to improve performance and offer a better user experience.

The information collected includes number of visitors, pages visited and time spent on the website. The information is collected by Google Analytics an aggregated and anonymous form, and we use the data to help us make improvements to the website. Marketing cookies	NID	These cookies are used by Google to show you relevant and engaging ads.
